Denver Health operates a network SBHCs in Denver Public Schools (DPS). These centers are open to all DPS students, including those enrolled in Early Childhood Education Programs.

Each SBHC is staffed by medical professionals who have extensive experience caring for children of all ages. Our caring doctors, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, and other specialized professionals care for children at each location.



In addition to the medical team, we also have Community Health Advisors, Health Educators, Licensed Mental Health Therapists, and Dental Hygienists on staff.
